

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5126

By SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON BUDGET

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, for the**
3 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$11,438,234.**

4 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
5 **\$4,983,939 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
6 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
7 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Bureau of Labor**
8 **and Industries.**

9 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
10 **\$589,900 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
11 **payment by the Bureau of Labor and Industries of administrative expenses from the Wage**
12 **Security Fund.**

13 **“(2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Bureau of Labor and**
14 **Industries for wage claim payments from the Wage Security Fund are not limited.**

15 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
16 **\$1,359,342 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
17 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Bureau of Labor and**
18 **Industries.**

19 **“SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
21 **July 1, 2005.”.**
