

A-Engrossed House Bill 5127

Ordered by the House May 27

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to _____ for biennial expenses.]
[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.]
[Limits biennial expenditures by _____ from federal funds.]

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Employment Department for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and including federal funds from Reed Act, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds collected or received by department.

Appropriates moneys from certain federal funds to department for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures of department from federal funds other than federal funds from Reed Act.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium**
6 **beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,551,585.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
8 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
9 **of expenses from fees, moneys, or other revenues, including moneys appropriated to the**
10 **Employment Department by section 3 of this 2005 Act, and including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
11 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds other than those described in section 3 of this**
12 **2005 Act, collected or received by the Employment Department:**

13 (1) **Operating budget \$103,773,270**

14 (2) **Debt service \$ 369,915**

15 **SECTION 3. There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium**
16 **beginning July 1, 2005, out of the funds made available to this state on March 13, 2002, under**
17 **section 903(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1103(d)), as amended, the amount of**
18 **\$29,688,319 to be used under the direction of the Employment Department for the purposes**
19 **of administering unemployment compensation law and public employment offices.**

20 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
21 **\$251,098,074 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**

1 **payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 3 of this 2005**
2 **Act collected or received by the Employment Department.**

3 **SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Employment**
4 **Department for unemployment insurance claims and for purposes of carrying out the federal**
5 **Trade Act are not limited.**

6 **SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
7 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
8 **July 1, 2005.**

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
