

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5129

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium be-
3 ginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$30,949,194.

4 “SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
5 \$151,594,041 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for
6 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
7 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of
8 Justice.

9 “SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
10 \$79,494,050 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for
11 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Justice.

12 “SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department
13 of Justice from the Criminal Injuries Compensation Account are not limited.

14 “SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department
15 of Justice from the Criminal Justice Revolving Account are not limited.

16 “SECTION 6. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures passed through as
17 special payments to other recipients, primarily district attorneys, for child support federal
18 matching and incentive funds are not limited.

19 “SECTION 7. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
20 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
21 July 1, 2005.”
