SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Justice for biennial expenses.
Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.
Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.
Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium be-**
6 **ginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$31,266,017.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
8 **\$151,594,041 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
9 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
10 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of**
11 **Justice.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
13 **\$79,494,050 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
14 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Justice.**

15 **SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department**
16 **of Justice from the Criminal Injuries Compensation Account are not limited.**

17 **SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department**
18 **of Justice from the Criminal Justice Revolving Account are not limited.**

19 **SECTION 6. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures passed through as**
20 **special payments to other recipients, primarily district attorneys, for child support federal**
21 **matching and incentive funds are not limited.**

22 **SECTION 7. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
23 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
24 **July 1, 2005.**
