

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5135

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality, for**
3 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the**
4 **following purposes:**

5 **“(1) Air quality..... \$ 3,306,252**

6 **“(2) Water quality..... \$ 12,532,399**

7 **“(3) Land quality..... \$ 1,043,961**

8 **“(4) Cross media \$ 672,716**

9 **“(5) Debt service..... \$ 4,387,306**

10 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
11 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
12 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, the**
13 **proceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and federal funds from the Bureau of Land**
14 **Management and United States Forest Service for smoke monitoring laboratory services, but**
15 **excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received**
16 **by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes:**

17 **“(1) Air quality..... \$ 35,641,920**

18 **“(2) Water quality..... \$ 15,798,192**

19 **“(3) Land quality..... \$ 41,421,616**

20 **“(4) Cross media \$ 1,561,244**

21 **“(5) Agency management..... \$ 19,883,593**

22 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
23 **\$3,719,599 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
24 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources**
25 **Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to implement**
26 **section 4 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.**

27 **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department**
28 **of Environmental Quality for debt service, for loans made from the Pollution Control Fund**
29 **and for loans made from the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund are not limited.**

30 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
31 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
32 **of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2005 Act col-**
33 **lected or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes:**

34 **“(1) Air quality..... \$ 6,478,481**

35 **“(2) Water quality..... \$ 14,128,456**

1 “(3) Land quality..... \$ 16,764,217

2 “(4) Cross media \$ 742,483

3 “**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law, neither the Department of Environmental
4 **Quality nor the Environmental Quality Commission may expend any moneys for the**
5 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, to adopt or enforce rules that impose California auto emis-**
6 **sion standards on motor vehicles sold, leased or titled in Oregon.**

7 “**SECTION 7.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
8 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
9 **July 1, 2005.”**
