

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5146

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium be-**  
3 **ginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts to be used for payment**  
4 **of expenses of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court, State Court Ad-**  
5 **ministrators and trial courts for the following purposes:**

6 (1) Operations..... \$256,236,244

7 (2) Mandated payments ..... \$ 12,526,573

8 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
9 **\$24,308,626 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
10 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
11 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Judicial Depart-**  
12 **ment.**

13 **“SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Judicial De-**  
14 **partment from amounts waived by jurors in accordance with ORS 10.075 (3), from the Court**  
15 **Forms Revolving Fund for costs of providing forms in accordance with ORS 21.363 and from**  
16 **the Judicial Department Collections Account established under ORS 1.204 (2) for payment of**  
17 **credit card fees or collection costs to the Department of Revenue or private collection**  
18 **agencies are not limited.**

19 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
20 **\$1,390,110 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
21 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Judicial Department.**

22 **“SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
23 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
24 **July 1, 2005.”**
