

A-Engrossed House Bill 5146

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [_____] **Judicial Department** for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [_____] **Judicial Department**.

Limits biennial expenditures by [_____] **Judicial Department** from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium begin-**
6 **ning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts to be used for payment of**
7 **expenses of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court, State Court Adminis-**
8 **trator and trial courts for the following purposes:**

9 (1) Operations..... \$256,236,244

10 (2) Mandated payments \$ 12,526,573

11 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
12 **\$24,308,626 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
13 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
14 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Judicial Depart-**
15 **ment.**

16 **SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Judicial De-**
17 **partment from amounts waived by jurors in accordance with ORS 10.075 (3), from the Court**
18 **Forms Revolving Fund for costs of providing forms in accordance with ORS 21.363 and from**
19 **the Judicial Department Collections Account established under ORS 1.204 (2) for payment of**
20 **credit card fees or collection costs to the Department of Revenue or private collection**
21 **agencies are not limited.**

22 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
23 **\$1,390,110 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
24 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Judicial Department.**

25 **SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**

1 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
