

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5147

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of State Lands, for the biennium**
3 **beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following**
4 **purposes:**

9 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
10 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
11 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
12 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of State**
13 **Lands, for the following purposes:**

15 **Council..... \$ 1,340**
16 (2) **South Slough National**
17 **Estuarine Research**
18 **Reserve operations..... \$ 795,421**
19 (3) **Common School Fund**

22 (5) **Oregon Wetlands Mitigation**
23 **Bank Revolving Fund**
24 **Account..... \$ 550,000**

25 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
26 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
27 **of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands, for**
28 **the following purposes:**

- 29 (1) **Natural Heritage Advisory**
30 **Council..... \$ 70,966**
31 (2) **South Slough National**
32 **Estuarine Research**
33 **Reserve operations..... \$ 1,323,994**
34 (3) **Common School Fund**
35 **programs..... \$ 516,719**

1 **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department**
2 **of State Lands for distribution of interest earnings on the Common School Fund to counties**
3 **for apportionment among the school districts of the county, unclaimed property finders fees**
4 **and State Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are not limited.**

5 **“SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
6 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
7 **July 1, 2005.”.**
