

A-Engrossed House Bill 5147

Ordered by the House July 1

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [_____] **Department of State Lands** for **certain** biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [_____] **department**.

Limits biennial expenditures by [_____] **department** from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of State Lands, for the biennium**
6 **beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following**
7 **purposes:**

- 8 (1) **Natural Heritage Advisory**
- 9 **Council..... \$ 28,991**
- 10 (2) **Common School Fund**
- 11 **programs..... \$ 149,816**

12 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
13 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
14 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
15 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of State**
16 **Lands, for the following purposes:**

- 17 (1) **Natural Heritage Advisory**
- 18 **Council..... \$ 1,340**
- 19 (2) **South Slough National**
- 20 **Estuarine Research**
- 21 **Reserve operations..... \$ 795,421**
- 22 (3) **Common School Fund**
- 23 **programs..... \$ 13,492,409**
- 24 (4) **Capital improvements..... \$ 487,009**
- 25 (5) **Oregon Wetlands Mitigation**

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands, for the following purposes:

(1) Natural Heritage Advisory Council..... \$ 70,966

(2) South Slough National Estuarine Research Reserve operations..... \$ 1,323,994

(3) Common School Fund programs..... \$ 516,719

SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Department of State Lands for distribution of interest earnings on the Common School Fund to counties for apportionment among the school districts of the county, unclaimed property finders fees and State Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are not limited.

SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
