

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5151

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Office of the Governor, for the biennium be-**
3 **ginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,864,804.**

4 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
5 **priated to the Office of the Governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$50,000 for the necessary expenses of the Governor in con-**
7 **nection with the duties imposed by law and for such other expenses as may be incumbent**
8 **upon or requested by the Governor.**

9 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
10 **\$1,722,657 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
11 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**
12 **nomical Development Fund to the Office of the Governor for the Economic Revitalization**
13 **Team.**

14 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
15 **\$1,144,249 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
16 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
17 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Office of the**
18 **Governor.**

19 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
20 **\$129,143 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
21 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Office of the Governor.**

22 **“SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
23 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
24 **July 1, 2005.”**
