SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [_____] **Office of Governor** for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from lottery moneys for Economic Revitalization Team.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [_____] **Office of Governor.**

Limits biennial expenditures by [_____] **Office of Governor** from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Office of the Governor, for the biennium be-**
6 **ginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,864,804.**

7 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
8 **ated to the Office of the Governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the Gen-**
9 **eral Fund, the amount of \$50,000 for the necessary expenses of the Governor in connection**
10 **with the duties imposed by law and for such other expenses as may be incumbent upon or**
11 **requested by the Governor.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
13 **\$1,722,657 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
14 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**
15 **nomic Development Fund to the Office of the Governor for the Economic Revitalization**
16 **Team.**

17 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
18 **\$1,144,249 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
19 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
20 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Office of the**
21 **Governor.**

22 **SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$129,143**
23 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of**
24 **expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Office of the Governor.**

25 **SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**

1 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
