

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 5155

By SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON BUDGET

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 5 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3  
2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for  
4 the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for  
5 payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee for the following pur-  
6 poses:

7 (1) General program..... \$ 20,078,626

8 (2) Committees and task

9 forces ..... \$ 77,552

10 (3) Debt service ..... \$ 1,428,927

11 **“SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
12 \$4,357,311 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for  
13 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
14 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-  
15 ministration Committee.

16 **“SECTION 3.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Legislative  
17 Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies  
18 Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.

19 **“SECTION 4.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-  
20 ning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$15,972,929 for payment of the ex-  
21 penses of the Seventy-third Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

22 **“SECTION 5.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium  
23 beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$10,752,831 for payment of the  
24 expenses of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

25 **“(2)** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, including the appropriation  
26 made by section 4 of this 2005 Act, any difference between the amount appropriated by sec-  
27 tion 65 (1), chapter 710, Oregon Laws 2003, and the amount actually expended within the ap-  
28 propriation on or before June 30, 2005, is considered an appropriation for payment of  
29 expenses of the Seventy-third Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

30 **“SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
31 \$196,988 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for  
32 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
33 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative As-  
34 sembly of the State of Oregon.

35 **“SECTION 7.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Legislative

1 Administration Committee from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117  
2 for the costs of food served in members' lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the  
3 basis of sales or by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

4 "SECTION 8. There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the  
5 biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,834,261.

6 "SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
7 \$1,118,734 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for  
8 payment of expenses by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account  
9 established by ORS 171.305 for personnel costs connected with the editing of the Oregon Re-  
10 vised Statutes.

11 "SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
12 \$116,982 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for  
13 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
14 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel  
15 Committee from state agencies or other offices for bill drafting and any other legal services  
16 authorized or required by law to be rendered by the Legislative Counsel Committee, including  
17 duties under ORS 183.710 to 183.725 provided pursuant to policies established by the Legisla-  
18 tive Counsel Committee.

19 "SECTION 11. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Legislative  
20 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from  
21 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies  
22 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised  
23 Statutes, are not limited.

24 "SECTION 12. There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium  
25 beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,597,509.

26 "SECTION 13. There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium  
27 beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,553,007.

28 "SECTION 14. There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the  
29 biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$336,284.

30 "SECTION 15. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$5,925  
31 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of  
32 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
33 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian  
34 Services.

35 "SECTION 16. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
36 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect  
37 July 1, 2005."  
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
