

B-Engrossed House Bill 5155

Ordered by the Senate July 29
Including House Amendments dated July 1 and Senate Amendments
dated July 29

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Legislative Administration Committee, Legislative Assembly, Legislative Counsel Committee, Legislative Fiscal Officer, Legislative Revenue Officer and Commission on Indian Services for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by certain legislative branch agencies.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for payment**
7 **of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee for the following purposes:**

8 (1) **General program..... \$ 20,078,626**

9 (2) **Committees and task**
10 **forces \$ 77,552**

11 (3) **Debt service \$ 1,428,927**

12 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
13 **\$4,357,311 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
14 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
15 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-**
16 **ministration Committee.**

17 **SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Legislative**
18 **Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies**
19 **Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.**

20 **SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-**
21 **ning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$15,972,929 for payment of the ex-**
22 **penses of the Seventy-third Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.**

23 **SECTION 5. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium be-**
24 **ginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$10,752,831 for payment of the**

1 expenses of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

2 (2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, including the appropriation
3 made by section 4 of this 2005 Act, any difference between the amount appropriated by sec-
4 tion 65 (1), chapter 710, Oregon Laws 2003, and the amount actually expended within the ap-
5 propriation on or before June 30, 2005, is considered an appropriation for payment of
6 expenses of the Seventy-third Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

7 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$196,988
8 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of
9 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
10 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Assembly of
11 the State of Oregon.

12 **SECTION 7.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Legislative
13 Administration Committee from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117
14 for the costs of food served in members' lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the
15 basis of sales or by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

16 **SECTION 8.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
17 biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,834,261.

18 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
19 \$1,118,734 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for
20 payment of expenses by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account
21 established by ORS 171.305 for personnel costs connected with the editing of the Oregon Re-
22 vised Statutes.

23 **SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
24 \$116,982 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for
25 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
26 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel
27 Committee from state agencies or other offices for bill drafting and any other legal services
28 authorized or required by law to be rendered by the Legislative Counsel Committee, including
29 duties under ORS 183.710 to 183.725 provided pursuant to policies established by the Legisla-
30 tive Counsel Committee.

31 **SECTION 11.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Legislative
32 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from
33 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
34 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised
35 Statutes, are not limited.

36 **SECTION 12.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
37 beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,597,509.

38 **SECTION 13.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium
39 beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,553,007.

40 **SECTION 14.** There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
41 biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$336,284.

42 **SECTION 15.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$5,925
43 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of
44 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
45 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian

1 **Services.**

2 **SECTION 16. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
3 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
4 **July 1, 2005.**

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
