

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5158

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the**
3 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the fol-**
4 **lowing purposes:**

- 5 (1) **Administrative and Support**
6 **Services..... \$ 1,250,861**
7 (2) **Food Safety \$ 6,297,619**
8 (3) **Natural Resources \$ 2,880,727**
9 (4) **Agricultural Development..... \$ 2,254,297**

10 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
11 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
12 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-**
13 **cluding federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not**
14 **described in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for**
15 **the following purposes:**

- 16 (1) **Administrative and Support**
17 **Services..... \$ 5,805,178**
18 (2) **Food Safety \$ 17,846,727**
19 (3) **Natural Resources \$ 14,153,474**
20 (4) **Agricultural Development..... \$ 8,586,678**

21 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
22 **\$11,216,224 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
23 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources**
24 **Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for the Oregon Plan, to be used for salmon and**
25 **watershed activities.**

26 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
27 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
28 **of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2005 Act col-**
29 **lected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for the following purposes:**

- 30 (1) **Food Safety \$ 585,633**
31 (2) **Natural Resources \$ 4,142,765**
32 (3) **Agricultural Development..... \$ 64,874**

33 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$34,000**
34 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of**
35 **expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-**

1 **opment Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for deposit in the County Fair Account**
2 **established by ORS 565.445, to support county fairs.**

3 **“SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
4 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
5 **July 1, 2005.”**
