

A-Engrossed House Bill 5158

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [_____] **State Department of Agriculture** for **certain** biennial expenses.

Limits **certain** biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts **and certain federal funds**, but excluding lottery funds and **other** federal funds, collected or received by [_____] **department**.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures by [_____] **department** from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the fol-**
7 **lowing purposes:**

- 8 (1) **Administrative and Support**
- 9 **Services..... \$ 1,250,861**
- 10 (2) **Food Safety \$ 6,297,619**
- 11 (3) **Natural Resources \$ 2,880,727**
- 12 (4) **Agricultural Development..... \$ 2,254,297**

13 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
14 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
15 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-**
16 **cluding federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not**
17 **described in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for**
18 **the following purposes:**

- 19 (1) **Administrative and Support**
- 20 **Services..... \$ 5,805,178**
- 21 (2) **Food Safety \$ 17,846,727**
- 22 (3) **Natural Resources \$ 14,153,474**
- 23 (4) **Agricultural Development..... \$ 8,586,678**

24 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
25 **\$11,216,224 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**

1 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources
2 Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for the Oregon Plan, to be used for salmon and
3 watershed activities.

4 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
5 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment
6 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2005 Act col-
7 lected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for the following purposes:

- 8 (1) Food Safety \$ 585,633
- 9 (2) Natural Resources \$ 4,142,765
- 10 (3) Agricultural Development..... \$ 64,874

11 **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$34,000
12 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of
13 expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-
14 opment Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for deposit in the County Fair Account
15 established by ORS 565.445, to support county fairs.

16 **SECTION 6.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
17 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
18 July 1, 2005.
