

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5163

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “limiting expenditures;”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 18 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
4 **riated to the Director of Veterans’ Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of**
5 **the General Fund, the amount of \$631,000, which may be expended for education benefits for**
6 **veterans provided under ORS 408.010 to 408.090.**

7 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
8 **riated to the Director of Veterans’ Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of**
9 **the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000 which may be expended for the Oregon Veterans’**
10 **Emergency Financial Assistance Program created by section 6, chapter _____, Oregon**
11 **Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 3504).**

12 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
13 **riated to the Oregon Student Assistance Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
14 **2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$165,000, which may be expended for the Oregon**
15 **Troops to Teachers program established by section 9, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005**
16 **(Enrolled House Bill 3504).**

17 **“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
18 **riated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**
19 **General Fund, the amount of \$54,000, which may be expended for transportation needs re-**
20 **lated to the employment, training and education of veterans.**

21 **“SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
22 **riated to the Oregon Military Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of**
23 **the General Fund, the amount of \$350,000, which may be expended to reimburse persons for**
24 **the costs of resident annual hunting licenses and resident annual angling licenses as provided**
25 **in section 11, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 3504).**

26 **“SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
27 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
28 **July 1, 2005.”.**
