## A-Engrossed House Bill 5163

Ordered by the House July 28  
Including House Amendments dated July 28

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

### SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [\_\_\_\_\_] **Director of Veterans' Affairs, Oregon Student Assistance Commission, Employment Department and Oregon Military Department for certain** biennial expenses.

*[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by \_\_\_\_\_.]*

*[Limits biennial expenditures by \_\_\_\_\_ from federal funds.]*

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Director of Veterans' Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$631,000, which may be expended for education benefits for**  
7 **veterans provided under ORS 408.010 to 408.090.**

8 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
9 **ated to the Director of Veterans' Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
10 **General Fund, the amount of \$500,000 which may be expended for the Oregon Veterans'**  
11 **Emergency Financial Assistance Program created by section 6, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon**  
12 **Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 3504).**

13 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
14 **ated to the Oregon Student Assistance Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005,**  
15 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$165,000, which may be expended for the Oregon**  
16 **Troops to Teachers program established by section 9, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005**  
17 **(Enrolled House Bill 3504).**

18 **SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
19 **ated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
20 **General Fund, the amount of \$54,000, which may be expended for transportation needs re-**  
21 **lated to the employment, training and education of veterans.**

22 **SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
23 **ated to the Oregon Military Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the**  
24 **General Fund, the amount of \$350,000, which may be expended to reimburse persons for the**

1 **costs of resident annual hunting licenses and resident annual angling licenses as provided in**  
2 **section 11, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 3504).**

3 **SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
4 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
5 **July 1, 2005.**
