

# B-Engrossed House Bill 5164

Ordered by the Senate August 2  
Including House Amendments dated June 30 and Senate Amendments  
dated August 2

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Economic and Community Development Department for Oregon Arts Commission.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Authorizes nonlimited expenditures for certain loan payments.

**Allocates moneys from Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to Economic and Community Development Department for Oregon Community Development Fund.**

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring  
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Economic and Community Development De-**  
6 **partment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of**  
7 **\$1,271,458 for the Oregon Arts Commission.**

8 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
9 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**  
10 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**  
11 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Economic and Commu-**  
12 **nity Development Department, for the following purposes:**

13 (1) **Administration of department**  
14 **programs (operations)..... \$ 8,488,593**

15 (2) **Oregon Community**  
16 **Development Fund ..... \$ 23,951,166**

17 (3) **Arts and Cultural Trust ..... \$ 5,598,693**

18 (4) **Debt service ..... \$ 1,956,772**

19 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
20 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**  
21 **of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic De-**  
22 **velopment Fund to the Economic and Community Development Department, for the following**

12 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
13 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment  
14 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Economic and Community De-  
15 velopment Department, for the following purposes:

- 16 (1) Administration of department
- 17 programs (operations)..... \$ 1,435,304
- 18 (2) Oregon Community
- 19 Development Fund ..... \$ 32,910,538
- 20 (3) Arts..... \$ 1,692,142

21 **SECTION 5.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Economic and  
22 Community Development Department for loans from the following funds are not limited:

- 23 (1) Marine Navigation
- 24 Improvement Fund ..... ORS 777.267
- 25 (2) Oregon Business Development
- 26 Fund..... ORS 285B.092
- 27 (3) Oregon Entrepreneurial
- 28 Development Loan Fund..... ORS 285B.758
- 29 (4) Oregon Port Revolving Fund ORS 285A.708
- 30 (5) Safe Drinking Water
- 31 Revolving Loan Fund ..... ORS 285A.213
- 32 (6) Special Public Works Fund... ORS 285B.455
- 33 (7) Water Fund..... ORS 285B.563

34 **SECTION 6.** (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other allocation from the Adminis-  
35 trative Services Economic Development Fund, there is allocated for the fiscal year beginning  
36 July 1, 2006, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Economic  
37 and Community Development Department for the Oregon Community Development Fund, the  
38 amount in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund during the biennium  
39 beginning July 1, 2005, up to \$3,350,000, that has not been allocated by any other law for  
40 specific purposes.

41 (2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Economic and Community  
42 Development Department for payment of expenses of the department from lottery moneys  
43 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the department  
44 for the Oregon Community Development Fund, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, the  
45 limitation on expenditures for the department established by section 3 (2) of this 2005 Act is

1 increased by \$3,350,000.

2 **SECTION 7. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
3 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
4 **July 1, 2005.**
