17 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
18 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
19 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and in-**
20 **cluding federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not**
21 **described in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife,**
22 **for the following purposes:**

2 “SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
3 \$7,035,026 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for
4 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources
5 Fund to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for activities and projects to implement
6 section 4 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

7 “SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
8 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment
9 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2005 Act col-
10 lected or received by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the following purposes:

22 “SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
23 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
24 July 1, 2005.”
