

# B-Engrossed House Bill 5171

Ordered by the Senate July 11  
Including House Amendments dated June 30 and Senate Amendments  
dated July 11

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Occupational Therapy Licensing Board, State Mortuary and Cemetery Board and State Board of Pharmacy.  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Occupational Therapy Licensing Board and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) Initial occupational therapist license..... \$85/year
- (2) Renewal of occupational therapist license..... \$100/year
- (3) Initial occupational therapist license, out of state \$120
- (4) Initial occupational therapy assistant license, out of state \$80

**SECTION 2.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Mortuary and Cemetery Board and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) Funeral establishment license renewal..... \$350/year
- (2) Immediate disposition company license renewal ..... \$350/year
- (3) Crematory license renewal ... \$100/year  
plus \$2/cremation
- (4) Cemetery license renewal ..... \$4/interment
- (5) Licensed facility location change..... \$250
- (6) Initial facility application..... \$150

12       **SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the**  
13 **following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Board of Pharmacy and approved by**  
14 **the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:**

- 15       **(1) Remote dispensing machine**
- 16           **license .....           \$100/year**
- 17       **(2) Remote dispensing machine,**
- 18           **controlled substance registration   \$25/year**

19       **SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
21 **July 1, 2005.**

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
