

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5174

By SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON BUDGET

July 18

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete "limiting expenditures;".

2 Delete lines 5 through 18 and insert:

3 "**SECTION 1.** (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-  
4 propriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the  
5 General Fund, the amount of \$2,500,000, to be allocated to the Oregon Criminal Justice  
6 Commission for awarding grants for drug court programs as authorized by ORS 137.656, as  
7 amended by section 24, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 2485).

8 "(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated  
9 by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2006, the moneys remaining on that date be-  
10 come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

11 "**SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-  
12 priated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005,  
13 out of the General Fund, the amount of \$158,054, which may be expended for development,  
14 administration and evaluation of the drug court grant program authorized by ORS 137.656,  
15 as amended by section 24, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 2485).

16 "**SECTION 3.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-  
17 priated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the Gen-  
18 eral Fund, the amount of \$942,679, which may be expended for continuing the operation of  
19 drug courts in Benton, Marion, Malheur and Multnomah Counties.

20 "**SECTION 4.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-  
21 priated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out  
22 of the General Fund, the amount of \$40,000, which may be expended for the purposes of  
23 sections 19 to 21, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 2485).

24 "**SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-  
25 priated to the Oregon State Police, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the Gen-  
26 eral Fund, the amount of \$88,143, for payment of expenses related to increased demand for  
27 services of the forensic lab due to increased prosecution of cases related to methamphet-  
28 amine.

29 "**SECTION 6.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
30 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect  
31 July 1, 2005."
