SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [_____] **various agencies** for **methamphetamine-related** biennial expenses.
[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.]
[Limits biennial expenditures by _____ from federal funds.]
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** (1) **In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General**
6 **Fund, the amount of \$2,500,000, to be allocated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission**
7 **for awarding grants for drug court programs as authorized by ORS 137.656, as amended by**
8 **section 24, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 2485).**

9 (2) **If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**
10 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2006, the moneys remaining on that date be-**
11 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

12 **SECTION 2.** **In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
13 **ated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005,**
14 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$158,054, which may be expended for development,**
15 **administration and evaluation of the drug court grant program authorized by ORS 137.656,**
16 **as amended by section 24, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 2485).**

17 **SECTION 3.** **In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
18 **ated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General**
19 **Fund, the amount of \$942,679, which may be expended for continuing the operation of drug**
20 **courts in Benton, Marion, Malheur and Multnomah Counties.**

21 **SECTION 4.** **In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
22 **ated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out**
23 **of the General Fund, the amount of \$40,000, which may be expended for the purposes of**
24 **sections 19 to 21, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House Bill 2485).**

25 **SECTION 5.** **In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
26 **ated to the Oregon State Police, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General**

1 **Fund, the amount of \$88,143, for payment of expenses related to increased demand for ser-**
2 **vices of the forensic lab due to increased prosecution of cases related to methamphetamine.**

3 **SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
4 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
5 **July 1, 2005.**

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
