**SUMMARY**

**Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for Gresham Center for the Arts.**

**Reduces appropriations from General Fund to Department of Human Services for abstinence education.**

**Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services for pilot program with Marion County related to methamphetamine.**

**Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.**

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July**  
6 **1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, for the Gresham Center for the**  
7 **Arts.**

8 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the appropriation from the**  
9 **General Fund to the Department of Human Services for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005,**  
10 **for abstinence education programs, made by section 28, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2005**  
11 **(Enrolled House Bill 5023), is reduced by \$100,000.**

12 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
13 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of**  
14 **the General Fund, the amount of \$75,000, for a pilot program with Marion County related to**  
15 **methamphetamine.**

16 **SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
18 **July 1, 2005.**
