

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 7

1 On page 1 of the printed joint resolution, delete lines 14 through 16 and insert:

2 “SECTION 1a. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, this section and
3 sections 5a and 19 of this Article and the amendment to sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8a, 10, 11,
4 12, 13, 14, 17 and 18 of this Article, section 14, Article II, section 31, Article IV, and section
5 5, Article VI of this Constitution, by House Joint Resolution 7 (2005) become operative upon
6 the publication of the returns by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, as provided
7 in section 4 of this Article, for the regular general election held in 2006.

8 “(2) This section and sections 5a and 19 of this Article, and the amendment to sections
9 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8a, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 17 and 18 of this Article, section 14, Article II, section
10 31, Article IV, and section 5, Article VI of this Constitution, by House Joint Resolution 7
11 (2005) become operative on the effective date of House Joint Resolution 7 (2005) for the pur-
12 pose of nominating and electing a Lieutenant Governor at the regular general election held
13 in 2006. The Secretary of State shall by rule specify the manner in which persons may be
14 nominated for the office of Lieutenant Governor for purposes of the regular general election
15 held in 2006.

16 “(3) This section is repealed on January 2, 2008.”.

17 On page 4, delete lines 7 through 9 and insert:

18 “PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the
19 people for their approval or rejection at a special election held throughout this state on the
20 same date as the next primary election.”.
