

# House Resolution 4

Sponsored by Representative MINNIS; Representatives BOONE, BOQUIST, BROWN, CAMERON, DALLUM, GILMAN, HANNA, KITTS, KRIEGER, KROPP, MORGAN, NELSON, SCOTT, P SMITH

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Declares May 14, 2005, as Paul Hanneman Day in honor of former state Representative.

## HOUSE RESOLUTION

Whereas Paul Hanneman was elected to the House of Representatives in 1964 and thereafter represented the people of Tillamook County in the Legislative Assembly until 1991; and

Whereas Paul Hanneman, during his 26 years of service as a state legislator, played a major role in the sponsorship and passage of much of the state's landmark legislation, including the Bottle Bill, the Beach Bill, the Forest Practices Act, the Salmon-Trout Enhancement Program and the Oil Spill Control Act; and

Whereas his dedication to protecting the natural resources and environment of the State of Oregon may be further witnessed by his efforts to biologically control noxious weeds, preserve and protect the state's tidelands as shellfish habitat, curtail stream bank erosion along the state's waterways, rehabilitate the Tillamook State Forest, preserve Cape Kiwanda and spur public consciousness of the benefits to be realized from recycling and solid waste reduction; and

Whereas Paul Hanneman further represented the interests of his constituency as a member of the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners and the county's first land use planning commission and served on numerous other boards, commissions and organizations at both the state and local levels; and

Whereas 40 years ago, pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 15, the regular session of the Fifty-third Legislative Assembly adjourned sine die on Friday, May 14, 1965, at 8:05 p.m., marking the end of Paul Hanneman's first legislative session; now, therefore,

### **Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Oregon:**

That we, the members of the House of Representatives of the Seventy-third Legislative Assembly, do hereby declare May 14, 2005, as Paul Hanneman Day in recognition of his years of public service to the people of the State of Oregon; and be it further

Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be presented to Paul Hanneman as an expression of our esteem and appreciation.
