

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 3

By COMMITTEE ON GENERAL GOVERNMENT

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 3, insert:

2 “Whereas the Seventy-first Legislative Assembly recognized that public buildings were at risk  
3 from seismic events; and

4 “Whereas the Seventy-first Legislative Assembly adopted several measures relating to seismic  
5 safety for educational buildings, hospitals, fire stations and police stations; and

6 “Whereas the people of the State of Oregon adopted Articles XI-M and XI-N of the Oregon  
7 Constitution at the November 5, 2002, general election for the purpose of allowing the state to incur  
8 indebtedness in the form of general obligation bonds for the planning and implementation of seismic  
9 rehabilitation of these public buildings; and

10 “Whereas the purpose of this 2005 Act and Senate Bills 2, 4 and 5 (2005) is to assess specific  
11 needs, to provide for the issuance of bonds and to fund seismic rehabilitation; now, therefore,”.

12 In line 14, after the period insert “The funds for the seismic rehabilitation of critical public  
13 buildings under the grant program are to be provided from the issuance of bonds pursuant to the  
14 authority provided in Articles XI-M and XI-N of the Oregon Constitution.”.

15 In line 26, delete “re-”.

16 In line 27, delete “payment obligations” and insert “conditions” and after the period insert “The  
17 director shall also provide that the grant committee review grant applications and make a determi-  
18 nation of funding based on a scoring system that is directly related to the statewide needs assess-  
19 ment performed by the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.”.

20 Delete line 30.

21 On page 2, delete line 1.

22 In line 2, delete “(c)” and insert “(b)”.

23 In line 6, delete “(d)” and insert “(c)”.

24 In line 8, delete “(e)” and insert “(d)”.

25 In line 10, delete “(f)” and insert “(e)”.

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
