

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 55

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 6, delete “5” and insert “5a”.
- 2 On page 2, line 5, after “(1)” insert “(a)” and after “mapping” insert “; or”.
- 3 Delete line 6.
- 4 In line 7, delete “(2)” and insert “(b)”.
- 5 In line 9, delete “(a)” and insert “(A)”.
- 6 In line 11, delete “(b)” and insert “(B)” and after “in” delete the rest of the line and insert  
7 “subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, recog-”.
- 8 In line 13, delete “(c)” and insert “(C)”.
- 9 In line 14, delete “(3)” and insert “(2)”.
- 10 In line 15, delete “(4)” and insert “(3)”.
- 11 In line 17, delete “(5)” and insert “(4)”.
- 12 After line 30, insert:
- 13 **“SECTION 5a. The State Board of Examiners for Engineering and Land Surveying may**  
14 **issue a temporary permit to a person to practice photogrammetric mapping in this state,**  
15 **without an examination, for a period not to exceed six months. The board may not issue a**  
16 **temporary permit to the person more than once. The board may issue the temporary permit**  
17 **only if the person:**
- 18 **“(1) Pays the appropriate fee;**
- 19 **“(2) Is an applicant for registration under ORS 672.002 to 672.325;**
- 20 **“(3) Has, in the judgment of the board, met all qualifications for registration under ORS**  
21 **672.002 to 672.325 other than passing an examination; and**
- 22 **“(4) Is authorized to practice photogrammetric mapping in another jurisdiction in the**  
23 **United States or a foreign country, by a jurisdiction having authorization standards that the**  
24 **board considers equivalent to the standards for practicing photogrammetric mapping in this**  
25 **state.”.**
- 26 On page 6, delete lines 6 through 8 and insert:
- 27 **“(14) A person preparing maps or compiling databases depicting the distribution of natural or**  
28 **cultural resources, features or phenomena, if the maps or data are not intended to indicate the au-**  
29 **thoritative location of property boundaries, the precise shape or contour of the earth or the precise**  
30 **location of fixed works by humans.**
- 31 **“(15) A federal agency or its contractors, in the preparation of military maps, quadrangle**  
32 **topographic maps, satellite imagery or other maps or images that do not define real property**  
33 **boundaries.**
- 34 **“(16) A federal agency or its contractors, in the preparation or transcription of documents or**  
35 **databases into a Geographical Information System or Land Information System format, including but**

1 not limited to the preparation or transcription of federal census and other demographic data.  
2 “(17) A law enforcement agency or its contractors, in the preparation of documents or maps for  
3 traffic accidents, crime scenes or similar purposes depicting physical features or events or generat-  
4 ing or using georeferenced data involving crime statistics or criminal activities.  
5 “(18) A peace officer, as defined in ORS 161.015, or a fire service professional, as defined in ORS  
6 181.610, conducting, reporting on or testifying about or otherwise performing duties regarding an  
7 official investigation.  
8 “(19) A person creating general maps prepared for private firms or governmental agencies:  
9 “(a) For use as guides to motorists, boaters, aviators or pedestrians;  
10 “(b) For publication in a gazetteer or an atlas as an educational tool or reference publication;  
11 “(c) For use in the curriculum of any course of study;  
12 “(d) If produced by any electronic or print media, for use as an illustrative guide to the ge-  
13 ographic location of any event; or  
14 “(e) If prepared for conversational or illustrative purposes, including but not limited to for use  
15 as advertising material or user guides.”.  
16 In line 25, after “672.135” insert “or section 5a of this 2005 Act”.  
17 On page 7, delete lines 13 through 16.  
18 In line 17, delete “(i)” and insert “(h)”.

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
