SUMMARY

Extends disciplinary authority of State Board of Psychologist Examiners over certain licensees.

2 Relating to disciplinary authority of State Board of Psychologist Examiners.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 675.010 to**
5 **675.150.**

6 **SECTION 2. The lapse, suspension or revocation of a license issued under ORS 675.010**
7 **to 675.150 by the operation of law, by order of the State Board of Psychologist Examiners or**
8 **by the decision of a court of law, or the voluntary surrender of a license by a licensee, does**
9 **not deprive the board of jurisdiction to proceed with any investigation of or any action or**
10 **disciplinary proceeding against the licensee or to revise or render null and void an order**
11 **suspending or revoking the license.**
