SENATE BILL 64**

1       On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 18, insert:

2       “(5) As used in this section, ‘archaeological investigation’ means the physical assessment of an  
3       archaeological site, using subsurface probes or excavation, conducted in order to determine the  
4       boundaries of the site, the integrity of the site or the historical significance of the site or to mitigate  
5       unavoidable disturbances to the site.”.

6       On page 3, after line 16, insert:

7       “(a) ‘Archaeological investigation’ means the physical assessment of an archaeological site, us-  
8       ing subsurface probes or excavation, conducted in order to determine the boundaries of the site, the  
9       integrity of the site or the historical significance of the site or to mitigate unavoidable disturbances  
10      to the site.”.

11      In line 17, delete “(a)” and insert “(b)”.

12      In line 21, delete “(b)” and insert “(c)”.
