

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 94

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 419B.015 is amended to read:

3 “419B.015. **(1)(a)** A person making a report of child abuse, whether voluntarily or pursuant to
4 ORS 419B.010, shall make an oral report by telephone or otherwise to the local office of the De-
5 partment of Human Services, to the designee of the department or to a law enforcement agency
6 within the county where the person making the report is located at the time of the contact. [*Such*
7 *reports*] **The report** shall contain, if known, the names and addresses of the child and the parents
8 of the child or other persons responsible for care of the child, the child’s age, the nature and extent
9 of the abuse, including any evidence of previous abuse, the explanation given for the abuse and any
10 other information [*which*] **that** the person making the report believes might be helpful in establish-
11 ing the cause of the abuse and the identity of the perpetrator.

12 “**(b)** When a report **of child abuse** is received by the department, the department shall [*imme-*
13 *diately*] notify a law enforcement agency within the county where the report was made. When a
14 report **of child abuse** is received by a designee of the department, the designee shall notify, ac-
15 cording to the contract, either the department or a law enforcement agency within the county where
16 the report was made. When a report **of child abuse** is received by a law enforcement agency, the
17 agency shall [*immediately*] notify the local office of the department within the county where the re-
18 port was made.

19 “**(2) When a report of child abuse is received under subsection (1)(a) of this section, the**
20 **entity receiving the report shall make the notification required by subsection (1)(b) of this**
21 **section according to rules adopted by the department under section 3 of this 2005 Act.**

22 “**SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 419B.005 to**
23 **419B.050.**

24 “**SECTION 3.** (1) The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules establishing:

25 “(a) The time within which the notification required by ORS 419B.015 (1)(a) must be made. At
26 a minimum, the rules shall:

27 “(A) Establish which reports of child abuse require notification within 24 hours after receipt;

28 “(B) Provide that all other reports of child abuse require notification within 10 days after re-
29 ceipt; and

30 “(C) Establish criteria that enable the department, the designee of the department or a law
31 enforcement agency to quickly and easily identify reports that require notification within 24 hours
32 after receipt.

33 “(b) How the notification is to be made.”.
