

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 225

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “433.090.”
- 2 Delete line 3 and insert “433.235, 433.255, 433.267 and 433.282.”
- 3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete page 2.
- 4 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 34.
- 5 In line 35, delete “6” and insert “1”.
- 6 On page 4, line 13, delete “7” and insert “2”.
- 7 In line 19, delete “8” and insert “3”.
- 8 On page 6, delete lines 8 through 24 and insert:
- 9 **“SECTION 4.** ORS 433.282 is amended to read:
- 10 “433.282. (1) The Department of Human Services may require each post-secondary educational
- 11 institution, except a community college [*and*] **or** a career school, to require that each entering full-
- 12 time student [*born on or after January 1, 1957,*] has current immunizations [*against measles*], **as re-**
- 13 **quired for children attending school pursuant to rules adopted by the department under ORS**
- 14 **433.273**, prior to the student’s second quarter or semester of enrollment on an Oregon campus, using
- 15 procedures developed by the institution.
- 16 **“(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the department may require each**
- 17 **post-secondary educational institution, except a community college or a career school, to**
- 18 **document, using procedures developed by the institution, that each entering full-time student**
- 19 **has current immunizations, as required for children attending school pursuant to rules**
- 20 **adopted by the department under ORS 433.273, prior to the student attending classes if the**
- 21 **student will be attending the institution pursuant to a nonimmigrant visa.**
- 22 “[*2*] (3) The department [*of Human Services*] by rule shall establish immunization schedules and
- 23 may further limit the students and programs to which the requirement applies.
- 24 “[*3*] (4) The department [*of Human Services*] may conduct validation surveys to ensure com-
- 25 pliance with this section.”
