

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 240

April 5

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete the second “and”.

2 In line 3, after “ORS” delete the rest of the line and insert “352.066; and declaring an emer-  
3 gency.”.

4 In line 17, delete “shall” and insert “may”.

5 On page 2, line 2, after “ernments” insert “, the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission” and de-  
6 lete “Oregon”.

7 In line 8, delete “state-funded”.

8 In line 22, delete “shall” and insert “may”.

9 In line 36, after “ernments” insert “, the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission” and delete  
10 “Oregon”.

11 In line 42, delete “state-funded”.

12 On page 3, line 1, after “of” delete the rest of the line and delete lines 2 through 31 and insert  
13 “nine members appointed by the Governor.

14 “(2) The term of office of a member is two years. Before the expiration of the term of a member,  
15 the Governor shall appoint a successor whose term begins on January 1 next following. A member  
16 is eligible for reappointment. If a vacancy occurs for any reason, the Governor shall make an ap-  
17 pointment to become effective immediately for the unexpired term. The advisory committee may re-  
18 move a member if the member misses three consecutive meetings without prior approval of the  
19 chairperson of the advisory committee.”.

20 Delete lines 36 through 39 and insert:

21 “(5) Members of the advisory committee are not entitled to compensation or expenses and serve  
22 on the advisory committee on a volunteer basis.”.

23 After line 45, insert:

24 “**SECTION 4. The Governor shall make the appointments required by section 3 of this**  
25 **2005 Act no later than January 1, 2006.**

26 “**SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
27 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
28 **on July 1, 2005.”.**
