

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 240

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 19, delete “cost-benefit analyses of” and insert  
2 “objective, nonpartisan analyses of existing or proposed”.

3 In line 20, after “policies” insert “, which analyses may not be inconsistent with state or federal  
4 law or the Oregon or United States Constitution”.

5 In line 21, delete “childhood development programs” and insert “programs dealing with public  
6 safety professionalism, ethics in leadership and childhood development”.

7 In line 23, after “behavior” insert “or to improve professionalism in public safety careers”.

8 In line 25, after “justice” insert “, public safety professionalism, ethics in leadership”.

9 On page 2, line 2, after “justice” insert “, public safety professionalism, ethics in leadership” and  
10 after “is” insert “peer reviewed and”.

11 In line 3, after “policymakers” insert “, public agencies”.

12 In line 6, after “Commission” insert “, the Department of Public Safety Standards and  
13 Training”.

14 In line 7, after “policymaking” insert “, the application of best practices”.

15 Delete lines 12 and 13 and insert “evaluating criminal or juvenile justice programs developed  
16 for, but not necessarily limited to, preventing delinquency, reducing crime and improving  
17 professionalism in public safety careers.

18 “(5) Agencies, departments and officers of state and local governments may assist the Criminal  
19 Justice Research and Policy Institute in the performance of its functions and furnish information,  
20 data and advice as requested by the institute.”.

21 In line 28, delete “cost-benefit analyses of” and insert “objective, nonpartisan analyses of exist-  
22 ing or proposed”.

23 In line 29, after “policies” insert “, which analyses may not be inconsistent with state or federal  
24 law or the Oregon or United States Constitution”.

25 In line 30, delete “childhood development programs” and insert “programs dealing with public  
26 safety professionalism, ethics in leadership and childhood development”.

27 In line 32, after “behavior” insert “or to improve professionalism in public safety careers”.

28 In line 34, after “justice” insert “, public safety professionalism, ethics in leadership”.

29 In line 36, after “justice” insert “, public safety professionalism, ethics in leadership” and after  
30 “is” insert “peer reviewed and”.

31 In line 37, after “policymakers” insert “, public agencies”.

32 In line 40, after “Commission” insert “, the Department of Public Safety Standards and  
33 Training”.

34 In line 41, after “policymaking” insert “, the application of best practices”.

35 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 26 and insert “evaluating criminal or juvenile justice programs

1 developed for, but not necessarily limited to, preventing delinquency, reducing crime and improving  
2 professionalism in public safety careers.

3 “(5) Agencies, departments and officers of state and local governments may assist the Criminal  
4 Justice Research and Policy Institute in the performance of its functions and furnish information,  
5 data and advice as requested by the institute.

6 **“SECTION 3. The Oregon Criminal Justice Scientific Advisory Committee is established**  
7 **to provide assistance and advice to the Criminal Justice Research and Policy Institute. The**  
8 **director of the Mark O. Hatfield School of Government shall appoint the members of the**  
9 **advisory committee. In order to serve as a member of the advisory committee, a person**  
10 **must have earned a graduate degree in a related field from an accredited university.”.**

11 In line 27, delete “5” and insert “4”.

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
