**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Extends statute of limitation in certain cases if attorney dies before expiration of time allowed for commencement of action. *[Allows]* **Requires** client of deceased attorney to commence action not later than 180 days after death of attorney **or within time established by statute, whichever is later**, if attorney agreed to represent person in action and attorney-client relationship is confirmed in writing prepared by attorney or at direction of attorney.

2 Relating to statutes of limitation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 12.**

5 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the time established by statute for the commencement of**  
6 **an action, a person must commence the action within 180 days after the death of an attorney**  
7 **for the person, or within the time established by statute for the commencement of the**  
8 **action, whichever is later, if:**

9 (1) **The attorney has agreed to represent the person in the action;**

10 (2) **The attorney-client relationship between the person and the attorney is confirmed in**  
11 **a writing prepared by the attorney or at the direction of the attorney; and**

12 (3) **The attorney dies before the expiration of the time allowed by statute for com-**  
13 **menement of the action.**

14 **SECTION 3. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, section 2 of this 2005**  
15 **Act applies to all causes of action, whether arising before, on or after the effective date of**  
16 **this 2005 Act.**

17 (2) **Section 2 of this 2005 Act does not apply to any action in which an attorney dies be-**  
18 **fore the effective date of this 2005 Act.**
