

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 359

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after “185.420,” insert “185.520.”

2 In line 13, delete “a director” and insert “an administrator”.

3 Delete lines 15 through 18 and insert:

4 “(2) The Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall establish the
5 qualifications for and appoint the Administrator of the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office. The
6 Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall consult with the commissions
7 served by the office before appointing the Administrator of the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Of-
8 fice.”.

9 In line 19, delete “Director” and insert “Administrator”.

10 In line 22, delete “Director” and insert “Administrator”.

11 In line 24, delete “Director” and insert “Administrator”.

12 In line 27, delete “director” and insert “administrator”.

13 In line 30, delete “Director” and insert “Administrator”.

14 On page 2, line 22, after the period insert “To the extent possible, members appointed by the
15 Governor shall provide for representation from all areas of the state. All of the members of the
16 commission shall be residents of this state.”.

17 In line 45, after the period insert “To the extent possible, members appointed by the Governor
18 shall provide for representation from all areas of the state. All of the members of the commission
19 shall be residents of this state.”.

20 On page 3, after line 18, insert:

21 “**SECTION 7a.** ORS 185.520 is amended to read:

22 “185.520. (1) The membership of the Commission for Women shall be comprised of 11 members,
23 to include two representatives from the Legislative Assembly, one appointed by the President of the
24 Senate, one appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Nine members shall be ap-
25 pointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate pursuant to section 4, Article III, Oregon
26 Constitution. **To the extent possible, members appointed by the Governor shall provide for
27 representation from all areas of the state. All of the members of the commission shall be
28 residents of this state.**

29 “(2) Members appointed by the Governor shall serve for three-year terms. Legislators shall serve
30 two-year terms.

31 “(3) The Governor shall designate the chairperson of the commission to serve for a term of one
32 year.

33 “(4) Members shall meet at the call of the chairperson not less than three times annually.

34 “(5) Consistent with Oregon law, the commission may receive and accept funds for purposes
35 consistent with the creation of the commission.”.

1 In line 34, after "185.610." delete the rest of the line.

2 Delete lines 35 through 42 and insert:

3 "(1) The Commission on Asian Affairs is created. The commission has 11 members. Nine of the
4 11 members shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate under ORS
5 171.562 and 171.565. The President of the Senate shall appoint one senator as a member of the
6 commission, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one representative as a
7 member of the commission. To the extent possible, members appointed by the Governor shall provide
8 for representation from all areas of the state. All of the members of the commission shall be resi-
9 dents of this state."
