

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 359

2 “appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency”.

3 In line 25, delete “Subject to the availability of funds,”.

4 On page 2, line 44, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

5 On page 3, line 2, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

6 In line 25, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

7 In line 28, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

8 On page 4, line 9, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

9 In line 12, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

10 In line 41, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

11 In line 44, delete “Subject to the availability of funding,”.

12 On page 5, after line 3, insert:

13 **“SECTION 11. There is appropriated to the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office, for the**
14 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$333,203.**

15 **“SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
16 **\$184,672 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
17 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
18 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Advocacy**
19 **Commissions Office.**

20 **“SECTION 13. (1) Any amounts in the Commission on Hispanic Affairs Account, the**
21 **Commission on Black Affairs Account and the Commission for Women Account that are**
22 **unexpended on the effective date of this 2005 Act are transferred to the Oregon Advocacy**
23 **Commissions Office Account and may be used as provided in section 5 of this 2005 Act.**

24 **“(2) Any amounts that are unexpended on the effective date of this 2005 Act and that**
25 **were authorized to be expended by the Commission on Hispanic Affairs, the Commission on**
26 **Black Affairs, the Commission for Women and the Commission on Asian Affairs from re-**
27 **venues dedicated, continuously appropriated, appropriated or otherwise made available for**
28 **the purpose of administering and enforcing the duties, functions and powers of the commis-**
29 **sions are appropriated and transferred to and are available for expenditure by the Oregon**
30 **Advocacy Commissions Office for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, for the purpose of**
31 **administering and enforcing the duties, functions and powers of the office under sections 1**
32 **to 5 of this 2005 Act.**

33 **“SECTION 14. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
34 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
35 **on its passage.”.**
