CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to names for public properties; amending ORS 271.600; and repealing section 2, chapter 652, Oregon Laws 2001.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** ORS 271.600 is amended to read:

271.600. (1) As used in this section [*and section 2, chapter 652, Oregon Laws 2001*]:

(a) **“Indian tribe” has the meaning given that term in ORS 97.740.**

[(a)] (b) **“Public body” has the meaning given that term in ORS [192.410] 174.109.**

[(b)] (c) **“Public property” has the meaning given that term in ORS 131.705.**

(2) [*Except as required by federal law,*] A public body may not use the term “squaw” in the name of a public property.

(3) **When a public body changes a name that contains the term “squaw,” the public body shall consider as the replacement name a term or phrase in the language of an Indian tribe.**

(4) **Subsection (2) of this section does not apply if:**

(a) **Federal law requires the use of the term “squaw”; or**

(b) **The public property is a geographic feature that an agency of the United States names using the term “squaw.”**

**SECTION 2. Section 2, chapter 652, Oregon Laws 2001, is repealed.**
