

Senate Bill 483

Sponsored by Senator BEYER, Representative SUMNER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows Travel Information Council to apply to federal agency for permission to establish pilot program for retail sales in roadside rest areas. Authorizes council to choose vendors when permission is received.

Sunsets January 2, 2010.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Travel Information Council.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Travel Information Council may apply to an appropriate agency of**
5 **the United States for permission to establish a pilot program allowing retail sales of local**
6 **products in sign plazas or similar structures in roadside rest areas.**

7 **(2) When the Director of Transportation is satisfied that the council has received the**
8 **necessary permission from an appropriate agency of the United States, then notwithstanding**
9 **any provision of ORS 346.510 to 346.570, the council may operate the pilot program and may**
10 **select vendors using any criteria established by the council.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2005 Act is repealed on January 2, 2010.**
