

# Senate Bill 619

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH POLICY (at the request of Oregon Health Policy Commission)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends state medical assistance program to pregnant women with incomes no more than 250 percent of federal poverty guidelines.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state medical assistance program; amending ORS 414.706; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 414.706 is amended to read:

5 414.706. The Legislative Assembly shall approve and fund health services to the following per-  
6 sons:

7 (1) Persons who are categorically needy as described in ORS 414.025 (2)(n) and (o);

8 (2) Pregnant women with incomes no more than [185] **250** percent of the federal poverty guide-  
9 lines;

10 (3) Persons under 19 years of age with incomes no more than 200 percent of the federal poverty  
11 guidelines;

12 (4) Persons described in ORS 414.708; and

13 (5) Persons 19 years of age or older with incomes no more than 100 percent of the federal pov-  
14 erty guidelines who do not have federal Medicare coverage.

15 **SECTION 2.** **This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
16 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
17 **July 1, 2005.**
