

Senate Bill 705

Sponsored by Senator CARTER; Representatives HANSEN, SHIELDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Corrections to study and report to Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly on rates and types of infectious diseases of persons committed to physical and legal custody of department.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Corrections shall study and report to the Seventy-fourth**
5 **Legislative Assembly on the occurrence rates and types of infectious diseases in persons**
6 **committed to the physical and legal custody of the department.**
