

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 781

By COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “health” delete the rest of the line and  
2 insert “; creating new provisions; amending ORS 410.720, 430.625, 430.630, 430.640, 430.665 and  
3 430.675; and declaring an emergency.”.

4 On page 9, after line 15, insert:

5 “**SECTION 6.** ORS 410.720 is amended to read:

6 “410.720. (1) It is the policy of this state to provide [*for the*] mental health [*needs of*] **and ad-**  
7 **diction services for** all Oregon senior citizens **and persons with disabilities** through a compre-  
8 hensive and coordinated statewide network of local [*senior*] mental health services and alcohol and  
9 drug abuse education and treatment. These services should involve family and friends and be pro-  
10 vided in the least restrictive and most appropriate settings.

11 “(2) **The Department of Human Services shall facilitate the formation of local community**  
12 **partnerships between the senior, disability, mental health, alcohol and drug abuse and health**  
13 **care communities by supporting the development of program approaches including, but not**  
14 **limited to:**

15 “(a) **Mental health and addiction screenings and assessments in long term care settings;**

16 “(b) **Outreach services to seniors and persons with disabilities in their homes, including**  
17 **gatekeeper programs, neighborhood programs and programs designed for rural communities;**

18 “(c) **Multilingual and multicultural medical and psychiatric services for ethnic minorities**  
19 **with physical disabilities and hearing impairments;**

20 “(d) **Education and training for health care consumers, health care professionals and**  
21 **mental health and addiction services providers on mental health and addiction issues, pro-**  
22 **grams and services for seniors and persons with disabilities; and**

23 “(e) **Education and consultation services for primary care physicians treating seniors and**  
24 **persons with disabilities.**

25 “[~~(2)~~] (3) In carrying out the provisions of [*subsection (1)*] **subsections (1) and (2)** of this section,  
26 the department [*of Human Services*] shall:

27 “(a) Develop plans for service coordination **within the department; [and]**

28 “(b) Recommend budget provisions for the delivery of needed services **offered by the depart-**  
29 **ment; and**

30 “(c) **Develop plans for expanding mental health and addiction services for seniors and**  
31 **persons with disabilities to meet the increasing demand.**

32 “**SECTION 7.** The Director of Human Services or the Director of the Department of  
33 Corrections, as appropriate, shall dispense as written a prescription for a mental health drug  
34 for a person in the custody of an institution described in ORS 179.321 if the prescription  
35 specifies ‘dispense as written’ or contains the notation ‘D.A.W.’ or other words of similar

1 **meaning.**

2 **“SECTION 8. Section 7 of this 2005 Act applies to persons in the custody of an institution**  
3 **described in ORS 179.321 on or after the effective date of this 2005 Act.**

4 **“SECTION 9. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
5 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
6 **July 1, 2005.”.**

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
