

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 912

1 On page 3 of the printed bill, line 16, delete “pseudoephedrine” and insert “ephedrine,
2 pseudoephedrine or phenylpropanolamine, the salts, isomers or salts of isomers of ephedrine,
3 pseudoephedrine or phenylpropanolamine or a combination of any of these substances” and delete
4 “or physician” and insert “, physician or other licensed health care practitioner authorized to pre-
5 scribe pseudoephedrine”.

6 In line 35, after “(3)” insert “(a) Notwithstanding ORS 475.045, the State Board of Pharmacy
7 may not adopt rules that exempt a product containing ephedrine or pseudoephedrine from classi-
8 fication as a controlled substance unless the product consists of liquid-filled gelatin capsules or a
9 liquid preparation.

10 “(b)”.

11 In line 37, delete “pseudoephedrine” and insert “ephedrine, pseudoephedrine or
12 phenylpropanolamine”.

13 In line 38, delete “pseudoephedrine” and insert “ephedrine, pseudoephedrine or
14 phenylpropanolamine”.

15 In line 44, after the period insert “The State Board of Pharmacy may not require a licensed
16 veterinarian, physician or other licensed health care practitioner authorized to prescribe
17 pseudoephedrine to make or maintain a record of the sale or transfer of products under this sub-
18 section if the veterinarian, physician or other licensed health care practitioner makes and maintains
19 a record of the sale or transfer under other applicable laws or rules regarding prescribing and dis-
20 pensing regulated or controlled substances by veterinarians, physicians or other licensed health care
21 practitioners authorized to prescribe pseudoephedrine.”.

22 On page 8, line 13, after “remove” insert “a copy of”.

23 In line 15, after “distributor” insert “or may require the distributor to provide a copy of the
24 records” and delete “Instead of re-”.

25 Delete lines 16 and 17.

26 After line 19, insert:

27 “**SECTION 12. No later than July 1, 2006, the State Board of Pharmacy shall make any**
28 **amendments to its administrative rules that are necessary to bring the rules into compliance**
29 **with ORS 475.973 (3)(a).”.**
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
