

Senate Bill 1031

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RULES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes requirements for telephone directories.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to telephone directories.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 759.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) Any telephone directory provided to telephone customers in this state**
6 **must include a separate, blue-bordered section appearing near the front of the directory that**
7 **includes:**

8 (a) **The names, addresses and telephone numbers of government offices, including all city,**
9 **county, special district, regional authority, port, tribal, state and federal offices that are lo-**
10 **cated within the geographical area in which the directory is distributed;**

11 (b) **The names, addresses and telephone numbers of public schools that are located within**
12 **the geographical area in which the directory is distributed; and**

13 (c) **A government and human services guide as described in subsection (3) of this section.**

14 (2) **The separate, blue-bordered section required by subsection (1) of this section may**
15 **include toll-free and other telephone numbers for services available to customers that are**
16 **provided by agencies located outside of the geographical area in which the directory is dis-**
17 **tributed.**

18 (3) **Any telephone directory provided to more than _____ telephone customers in this**
19 **state must include within the separate, blue-bordered section required by subsection (1) of**
20 **this section a government and human services guide, including zip codes, maps, recycling**
21 **resources, energy conservation resources and other information of general interest or value**
22 **to the communities located within the geographical area in which the directory is distrib-**
23 **uted.**

24 (4) **The government and human services guide required by subsection (1) of this section**
25 **must include emergency services providers available within the geographical area in which**
26 **the directory is distributed, including all police and fire departments, poison control centers,**
27 **suicide counseling and mental health emergency counseling providers, domestic violence**
28 **victim resources, rape victim resources, child abuse victim resources, elder abuse victim**
29 **resources and other public entities and private nonprofit corporations providing human ser-**
30 **vices. The guide shall have classified headings for the available public and private nonprofit**
31 **emergency and nonemergency services. Local advisory committees may be used in compiling**
32 **and updating the guide.**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 **(5) The Public Utility Commission shall by rule establish standards for implementing**
2 **subsections 1 to 4 of this section.**
