

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1032

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “195.110” and insert “197.299”.

2 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

3 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 197.299 is amended to read:

4 “197.299. (1) A metropolitan service district organized under ORS chapter 268 shall complete the  
5 [*initial*] inventory, determination and analysis required under ORS 197.296 (3) not later than [*Janu-*  
6 *ary 1, 1998, and conduct*] **five years after completion of the previous inventory, determination**  
7 and analysis [*at least every five years thereafter*].

8 “(2)(a) The metropolitan service district shall take such action as necessary under ORS 197.296  
9 (6)(a) to accommodate one-half of a 20-year buildable land supply determined under ORS 197.296 (3)  
10 within one year of completing the analysis.

11 “(b) The metropolitan service district shall take all final action under ORS 197.296 (6)(a) neces-  
12 sary to accommodate a 20-year buildable land supply determined under ORS 197.296 (3) within two  
13 years of completing the analysis.

14 “(c) The metropolitan service district shall take action under ORS 197.296 (6)(b), within one year  
15 after the analysis required under ORS 197.296 (3)(b) is completed, to provide sufficient buildable land  
16 within the urban growth boundary to accommodate the estimated housing needs for 20 years from  
17 the time the actions are completed. The metropolitan service district shall consider and adopt new  
18 measures that the governing body deems appropriate under ORS 197.296 (6)(b).

19 “(3) The Land Conservation and Development Commission may grant an extension to the time  
20 limits of subsection (2) of this section if the Director of the Department of Land Conservation and  
21 Development determines that the metropolitan service district has provided good cause for failing  
22 to meet the time limits.

23 “(4)(a) **The metropolitan service district shall establish a process to expand the urban**  
24 **growth boundary to accommodate a need for land for a public school that cannot reasonably**  
25 **be accommodated within the existing urban growth boundary. The metropolitan service dis-**  
26 **trict shall design the process to:**

27 “(A) **Accommodate a need that must be accommodated between periodic analyses of ur-**  
28 **ban growth boundary capacity required by subsection (1) of this section; and**

29 “(B) **Provide for a final decision on a proposal to expand the urban growth boundary**  
30 **within four months after submission of a complete application by a high growth school dis-**  
31 **trict, as defined in ORS 195.110.**

32 “(b) **At the request of a high growth school district, the metropolitan service district**  
33 **shall assist the high growth school district to identify school sites required by the school**  
34 **facility planning process described in ORS 195.110. A need for a public school is a specific type**  
35 **of identified land need under ORS 197.298 (3).”.**
