

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1040

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and lines  
2 3 and 4 and insert “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 6 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance**  
5 **Code.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) On or before April 1 of each year, an insurer that offers health insur-**  
7 **ance in this state shall report to the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business**  
8 **Services payment information for the preceding year relating to the diagnostic related**  
9 **groups and procedures described in subsection (2) of this section.**

10 **“(2) The director, in consultation with the Health Insurance Reform Advisory Committee,**  
11 **shall adopt rules identifying the information to be contained in the report required by sub-**  
12 **section (1) of this section, including but not limited to the specific diagnostic related groups**  
13 **and procedures and the paid claims data for each diagnostic related group and procedure.**

14 **“(3) The director shall make the information reported under subsection (1) of this section**  
15 **available to the Office for Oregon Health Policy and Research.**

16 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Office for Oregon Health Policy and Research shall:**

17 **“(a) Aggregate the information received under section 2 of this 2005 Act before publicly**  
18 **disclosing any research, analyses or studies based on the information.**

19 **“(b) Publicly disclose reports on any research, analyses or studies conducted based on the**  
20 **information received under section 2 of this 2005 Act.**

21 **“(c) Determine the method and format for public disclosure of the information received**  
22 **under section 2 of this 2005 Act.**

23 **“(2) The office may:**

24 **“(a) Conduct research, analyses and studies of the information reported under section 2**  
25 **of this 2005 Act;**

26 **“(b) Identify specific health care facilities in publicly disclosed reports;**

27 **“(c) Not disclose any information that is identifiable to an individual patient; and**

28 **“(d) Not disclose any information that identifies individually negotiated contract rates**  
29 **or fees between hospitals or other health care providers and insurers.**

30 **“(3) The office shall make the information provided to the office under section 2 of this**  
31 **2005 Act available to the public through a public website on the Internet in a manner that**  
32 **allows for a comparison of information for specific health care facilities and specific diag-**  
33 **nostic related groups and procedures.**

34 **“SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
35 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**

1 **July 1, 2005.”**

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
