

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1071

1 On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon insert “creating new
2 provisions; amending ORS 338.125;”.

3 On page 2, line 4, after “other” insert “public”.

4 After line 35, insert:

5 **“SECTION 5.** ORS 338.125 is amended to read:

6 “338.125. (1) Student enrollment in a public charter school shall be voluntary. All students who
7 reside within the school district where the public charter school is located are eligible for enroll-
8 ment at a public charter school. If the number of applications from students who reside within the
9 school district exceeds the capacity of a program, class, grade level or building, the public charter
10 school shall select students through an equitable lottery selection process. However, after a public
11 charter school has been in operation for one or more years, the public charter school may give
12 priority for admission to students:

13 “(a) Who were enrolled in the school in the prior year; or

14 “(b) Who have siblings who are presently enrolled in the school and who were enrolled in the
15 school in the prior year.

16 “(2)(a) If space is available a public charter school may admit students who do not reside in the
17 school district in which the public charter school is located.

18 **“(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, if a public charter school offers
19 any online courses as part of the curriculum of the school, then 50 percent or more of the
20 students who attend the public charter school must reside in the school district in which the
21 public charter school is located.**

22 “(3) A public charter school may not limit student admission based on ethnicity, national origin,
23 race, religion, disability, gender, income level, proficiency in the English language or athletic ability,
24 but may limit admission to students within a given age group or grade level.

25 “(4) A public charter school may conduct fund-raising activities. However, a public charter
26 school shall not require a student to participate in fund-raising activities as a condition of admission
27 to the public charter school.”.

28 In line 36, delete “5” and insert “6”.
