

Senate Bill 1096

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RULES (at the request of Senator Laurie Monnes Anderson)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Transfers exclusive control of and jurisdiction over county roads within City of Gresham from Multnomah County to City of Gresham. Requires Multnomah County to transfer portion of State Highway Fund moneys to City of Gresham and to spend portion of moneys for county roads within Troutdale, Fairview and Wood Village.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transfer of jurisdiction over certain Multnomah County roads to City of Gresham.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The county roads within the corporate limits of the City of Gresham, in**
5 **Multnomah County, are transferred and designated to be within the exclusive control and**
6 **jurisdiction of the City of Gresham. These county roads are city streets, subject to all of the**
7 **burdens and servitudes of city streets. Multnomah County does not have control of or ju-**
8 **isdiction over the roads described in this subsection.**

9 **(2) Multnomah County shall transfer annually to the City of Gresham a percentage share**
10 **of the State Highway Fund moneys allocated to the county, less any moneys transferred to**
11 **other jurisdictions under intergovernmental agreements entered into before the effective**
12 **date of this 2005 Act, that is equal to the percentage share of county road miles transferred**
13 **to the City of Gresham under subsection (1) of this section.**

14 **(3) Multnomah County shall expend for county roads within each of the cities of**
15 **Troutdale, Fairview and Wood Village a percentage share of the State Highway Fund moneys**
16 **allocated to the county, less any moneys transferred to other jurisdictions by intergovern-**
17 **mental agreement, that is equal to or greater than the percentage share of county road miles**
18 **within each of the cities of Troutdale, Fairview and Wood Village.**

19 **SECTION 2. Within 90 days after the effective date of this 2005 Act, the governing bodies**
20 **of Multnomah County and the City of Gresham shall by intergovernmental agreement com-**
21 **plete the transfer of exclusive control of and jurisdiction over county roads required by**
22 **section 1 (1) of this 2005 Act and provide for the transfer of moneys required by section 1 (2)**
23 **of this 2005 Act.**
