**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

**Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by State Department of Agriculture.**  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) **Fertilizer, agricultural amendment and agricultural mineral inspection ..... \$ 0.35/ton**
- (2) **Virus fruit tree certification..... \$ 7 per test per plant**
- (3) **Annual nursery participation fee..... \$ 200**

**SECTION 2.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) **Livestock brand renewal (no change in expiration) - Nonsheep ..... \$ 100/4 years**
- (2) **Livestock brand renewal (no change in expiration) - Sheep ..... \$ 40/4 years**
- (3) **Livestock brand renewal - Nonsheep ..... \$ 25 per year**
- (4) **Livestock brand renewal**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

2           (5) Reactivation fee ..... \$ 25

3           **SECTION 3.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the  
4 following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and ap-  
5 proved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

6           (1) Pesticide operator..... \$ 90

7           (2) Pesticide applicator..... \$ 50

8           (3) Pesticide trainee ..... \$ 50

9           (4) Public applicator or trainee.. \$ 50

10          (5) Pesticide dealer..... \$ 75

11          (6) Consultant..... \$ 40

12          **SECTION 4.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the  
13 following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and ap-  
14 proved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

15          (1) Registration of animal  
16             remedy, pharmaceutical  
17             or veterinary biologic  
18             product ..... \$ 75 per product

19          (2) Autogenous products  
20             formulated ..... \$ 75 per product

21          **SECTION 5.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
22 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect  
23 July 1, 2005.
