

# A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5615

Ordered by the Senate July 6  
Including Senate Amendments dated July 6

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RULES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [\_\_\_\_\_] **Economic and Community Development Department** for **certain** biennial expenses.

Limits **certain** biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [\_\_\_\_\_] **department**.

**Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys.**

Limits biennial expenditures by [\_\_\_\_\_] **department** from federal funds.

**Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.**

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring  
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated to the Economic and Community Development De-  
6 partment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of  
7 \$1,280,232 for the Oregon Arts Commission.

8 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
9 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment  
10 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
11 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Economic and Commu-  
12 nity Development Department, for the following purposes:

- 13 (1) Administration of department
- 14 programs (operations)..... \$ 8,571,716
- 15 (2) Oregon Development Fund ..... \$ 23,951,166
- 16 (3) Arts and Cultural Trust ..... \$ 5,615,087
- 17 (4) Debt service ..... \$ 1,956,772

18 **SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
19 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment  
20 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic De-  
21 velopment Fund to the Economic and Community Development Department, for the following  
22 purposes:

- 23 (1) Administration of department
- 24 programs (operations)..... \$ 16,213,612

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

- 1       **(2) Oregon Development Fund .....** \$ 25,284,616
- 2       **(3) Oregon Film and Video Office ..** \$ 841,605
- 3       **(4) Debt service (pass-through).....** \$ 49,670,509

4       **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
5       **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**  
6       **of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Economic and Community De-**  
7       **velopment Department, for the following purposes:**

- 8       **(1) Administration of department**  
9       **programs (operations).....** \$ 1,458,729
- 10       **(2) Oregon Development Fund .....** \$ 32,910,538
- 11       **(3) Arts.....** \$ 1,694,413

12       **SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Economic and**  
13       **Community Development Department for loans from the following funds are not limited:**

- 14       **(1) Marine Navigation**  
15       **Improvement Fund .....** ORS 777.267
- 16       **(2) Oregon Business Development**  
17       **Fund.....** ORS 285B.092
- 18       **(3) Oregon Entrepreneurial**  
19       **Development Loan Fund.....** ORS 285B.758
- 20       **(4) Oregon Port Revolving Fund** ORS 285A.708
- 21       **(5) Safe Drinking Water**  
22       **Revolving Loan Fund.....** ORS 285A.213
- 23       **(6) Special Public Works Fund...** ORS 285B.455
- 24       **(7) Water Fund.....** ORS 285B.563

25       **SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
26       **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
27       **July 1, 2005.**
