20 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Department of Fish**

1 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
2 **\$7,035,026** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for
3 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources
4 Fund to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for activities and projects to implement
5 section 4 (10), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

6 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
7 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment
8 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Department of Fish and
9 Wildlife, for the following purposes:

21 “**SECTION 5.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
22 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
23 **July 1, 2005.**”
